- Developed their own line of piers
- Also carry name brand piers such as Shore Master

- Do many shoreline protection projects. These vary by municipalities
- Install plastic seawalls
- Work in winter using ice roads
- They have large and small barges
- A boat lift can be set in 15 minutes using their equipment
- Installed many kayaks ramps for many municipalities. ADA compliant ramp costs around \$30,000
- Kayak ramps can be added to piers but cannot be installed permanently
