MCLA 2025 Annual Meeting and Banquet was held at the Viking Bow & Gun Club on Saturday October 11, 2025. It was organized by the English Lake Association in conjunction with the Manitowoc County Lakes Association.

The meal was great, super tasty food catered in by the Altona Supper Club in New Holstein. A big thank you to Kim Braun from English Lake who took the bull by the horns and set everything up. After the meal we had our guest speaker Phil DeCastro, a meteorologist from WLUK TV FOX 11 in Green Bay. Phil explained how he got into being a weather man and exactly how weather is determined over a period of time. It was remarkably interesting and the story of meeting his wife from Mishicot was also interesting. Phil took a lot of questions from the group, and all really enjoyed it.

Meeting called to order by MCLA President Jerry Corfman.

- Jerry mentioned that Scott Umland was gone on vacation and Roger was covering for him as secretary. Jerry asked for a motion to accept the 8-28-25 secretary's report on the website to approve the minutes of that meeting. Motion was made and seconded.  somehow go to a two-year term, which will have to be figured out. Motion was
 accepted.
