MCLA 2025 Annual Meeting and Banquet was held at the Viking Bow & Gun Club on Saturday October 11, 2025. It was organized by the English Lake Association in conjunction with the Manitowoc County Lakes Association.

After the meal we had our guest speaker Phil DeCastro, a meteorologist from WLUK TV FOX 11 in Green Bay. Phil explained how he got into being a weather man and exactly how weather is determined over a period of time. It was remarkably interesting and the story of meeting his wife from Mishicot was also interesting. Phil took a lot of questions from the group, and all really enjoyed it.

Motion was made to allow a one-year term for this year, and at the next election they will somehow go to a two-year term, which will have to be figured out. Motion was accepted.
- Next meeting will be at 6:30 pm on Nov. 20<sup>th</sup> in Room 300 at the County Offices Building. Cedar Lake volunteered to host the 2026 banquet.

Raffle and door prizes were given out after this.
